**The Rev. Dr. Harold Lewis, rector of Calvary Church Pittsburgh, Visits Trinity Cathedral**

CLEVELAND—On Wednesday, November 29, Trinity Cathedral Cleveland will host the Rev. Dr. Harold Lewis, rector of Calvary Church Pittsburgh. Dr. Lewis will preach at Evensong at 6 pm, a simple supper will be served at 7 pm and Dr. Lewis will present a forum at 7:30 pm.

Dr. Lewis has been the rector of Calvary since 1996; the church is a leader of the mainstream Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Pittsburgh. He is the first recipient of the Lawrence Krisitan Mikkelsen Prize for excellence in prophetic preaching. Among Dr. Lewis's publications are *Yet With a Steady Beat: the African American Struggle for Recognition in the Episcopal Church*, *Christian Social Witness*, and *Elijah's Mantle: Pilgrimage, Politics and Proclamation*. He is a member of the Episcopal Church Foundations Fellows' Forum and the board of Seabury-Western Theological Seminary. By appointment of the Archbishop of Canterbury, he serves on the Advisory Council for the Anglican Observer to the United Nations, of which he is the former chair. Dr. Lewis holds a Bachelor of Arts from McGill University, a Master of Divinity from Yale University, and a Doctor of Philosophy from the University of Birmingham (England), and has also been awarded honorary degrees by the Berkeley Divinity School at Yale and the Seabury-Western Theological Seminary.
