Trinity Cathedral Webcast of the Investiture of Katharine Jefferts Schori

CLEVELAND— On Saturday, November 4 at 11 am, Trinity Cathedral Cleveland will host Eucharist and a live webcast of the Investiture of Katharine Jefferts Schori, who was elected the 26th Presiding Bishop of the Episcopal Church in June. A reception at Trinity will follow the service, broadcast live via the web from the National Cathedral in Washington D.C.

Jefferts Schori, a former university professor who is an experienced oceanographer and airplane pilot, has served as bishop of the Diocese of Nevada since 2001. As Presiding Bishop, Jefferts Schori will become chief pastor to the Episcopal Church, which includes more than 2.4 million members in some 7600 congregations in 111 dioceses spanning 16 countries. She is the first woman in the five centuries of Anglicanism to lead the church.
